



Spooky Spiderweb Craft

Materials:

- 6 popsicle sticks
- Yarn or string (about 1-2 ft)
- Glue
- Black construction paper
- Scissors
- Crayons or markers

1. Color your the popsicle sticks and glue them together in a star shape.
2. While they're drying, roll a small square of construction paper into a ball for the spider's body, and glue down any loose edges.
3. Cut out 8 thin pieces of construction paper and fold them in half to make spider legs.
4. Glue 4 legs together to form a fan shape, and then glue the second 4.
5. Glue both sets of legs together, and then glue the spider's body onto the legs.
6. Tie the end of the string to the center of the web.
7. Wind the string around the web, tying a knot on each popsicle stick.
8. Glue the spider on your web!
