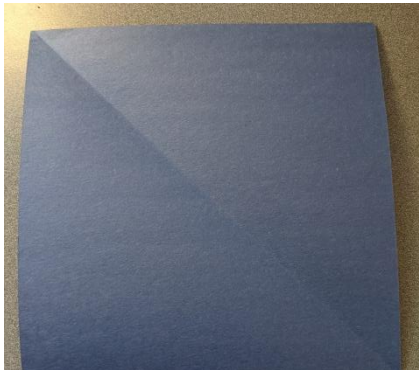
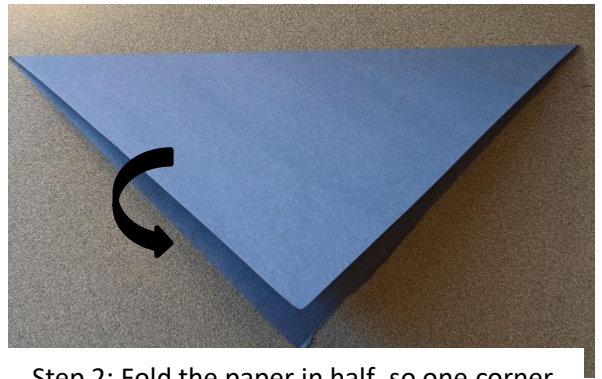


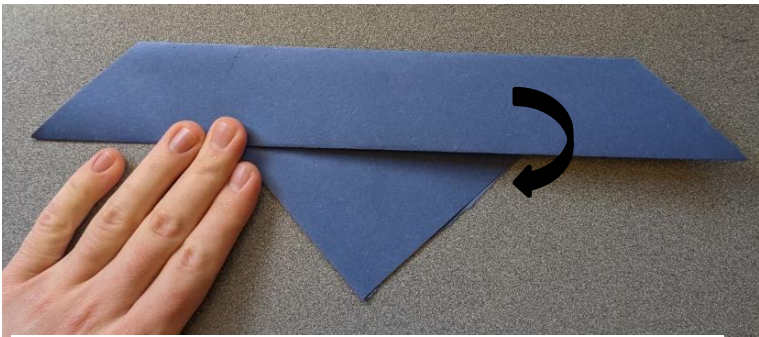
How to make an origami winter bird!



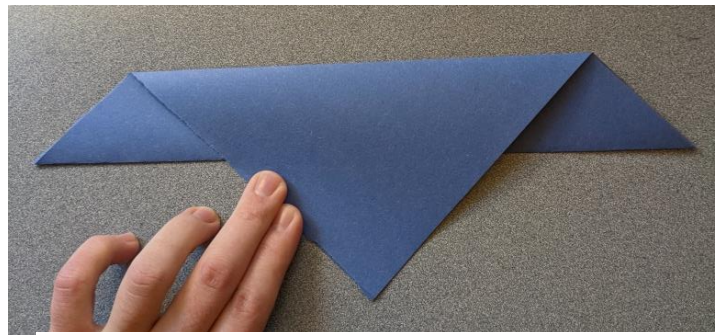
Step 1: Cut or tear your paper into a square.



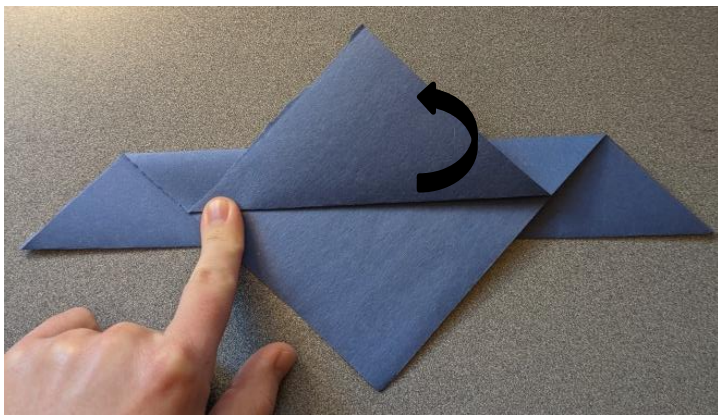
Step 2: Fold the paper in half, so one corner touches the other corner.



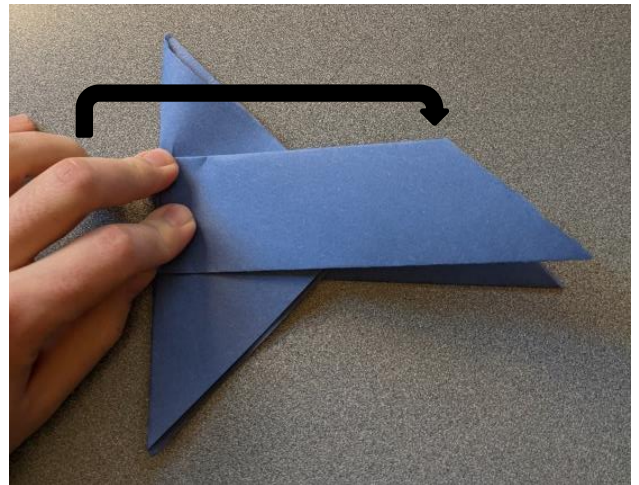
Step 3: Fold the top part of your triangle down about midway.



Step 4: flip your piece over



Step 5: Fold the top layer of your triangle up

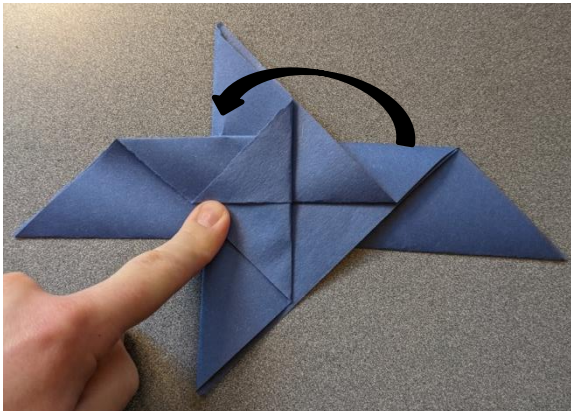


Step 6: Fold in half lengthwise so both corners line up

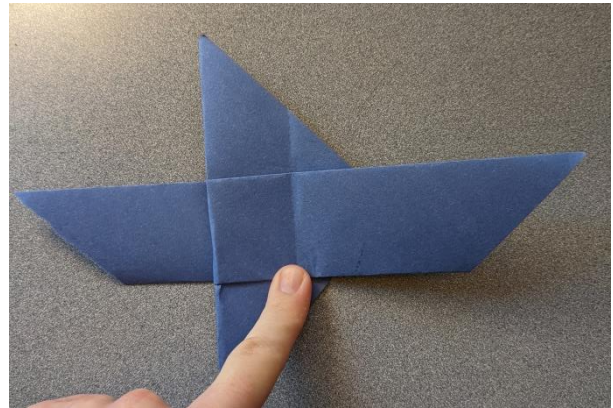

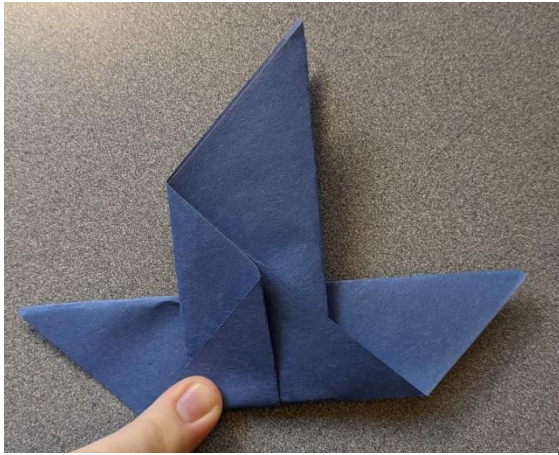

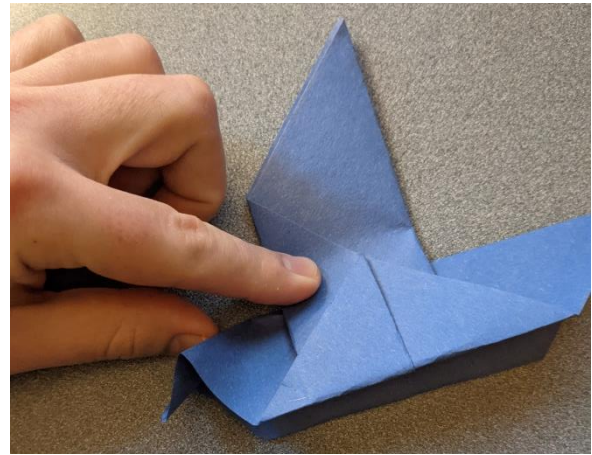
Step 7: Fold back one side, this will be one wing



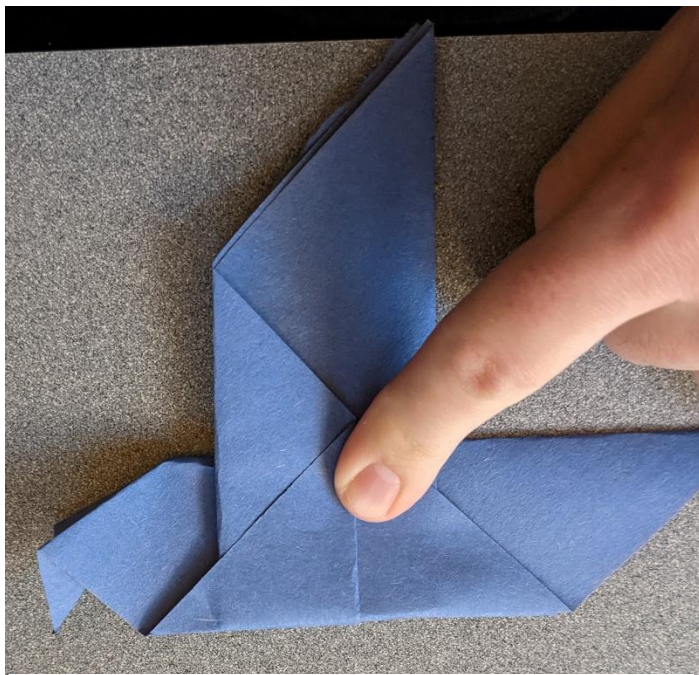
Step 8: Flip over



Step 9: Repeat step 7 to create the second wing.



Step 10: Make the head by pushing down into the front section.



All done! You can fold the wings down to create a bird in mid-flight or do different color birds like red for a cardinal!
