

EcoCamp 2024 Scholarship Application

Scholarship Information

Generous community members have made donations to Pickering Creek that allow us to provide scholarships for students in need to attend this year's EcoCamp.

If you are granted a scholarship, you are responsible for a non-refundable deposit (\$90). The deposit must be paid to reserve your camper's spot. Scholarship awards will be given for the remaining cost of one week of camp, per child per household. Scholarships are granted based on need, space availability, and completeness of the application process.

At the end of the determination period a second week's scholarship may be awarded, depending on the demand for scholarships this year. You will still need to pay the deposit for any additional weeks you are awarded a scholarship for.

Campers will also be asked to write a short story or draw a picture (depending on age) at the end of the camp week about what their camp experience meant to them. The scholarship application page follows.
